Temporary Exhibits

Resurgo Place annually hosts three to four temporary exhibits that travel from different museums across the country. These high-quality exhibits all have accompanying education material and offer various subjects and themes to explore. Here are the upcoming exhibits for 2019-2020:

HOCKEY

September 21, 2019 - January 12, 2020 A traveling exhibition developed by the Canadian Museum of History

The sweat-soaked smell of the dressing room. The flick of the wrist-shot. The roar of the fans. For millions of Canadians, winter means hockey and hockey means everything. Be there when the puck drops on Hockey. Trace the sport's evolution through historic highlight reels, interactive components and one-of-a-kind artifacts. Explore the places where Canadians live and breathe hockey: from dressing room to press-box, rink to corporate boardroom, players' bench to the backyard game. Find out why hockey holds pride of place in the hearts of Canadians.

SOUND, JUST SOUND!

January 25, 2020 - April 5, 2020 A traveling exhibition developed by the Sherbrooke Museum of Nature and Science
